Ableton 9 Instrument Rack



Editing Tools:

- Sample Selector > Switch between key mapped one shots on the fly, playable across the keyboard.
- Filter > A 12-db low pass filter run to soften and clean your sound.
- Intensity > Add drive, frequency modulation and pitch envelope to crank the intensity.
- Pluck > Add some bite to your sound with some filter resonance and filter envelope. Use this control alongside the Filter for maximal sonic effect.
- ADS > Use the Attack, Decay & Sustain parameters to take control of your transients.
- Slide > Add some portamento to your sound with our simple Slide control.

Processing Tools:

- Dirt > Dial in for instant distortion, beefing up your sound with maximum grit.
- Clarity > Dial in some Clarity using this all-new bespoke EQ and saturation rack.
- Phaser & Chorus > Add some separation and width to your sound with our bespoke Phaser and Chorus modules
- Flutter > Dial-in flutter and width with our bespoke auto pan module
- Delay > Add some tripped out delay with our techno inspired delay line.
- Space > From subtle and smooth to aggressive and metallic, add an extra dimension to your sound with our Space reverb module.
