Ableton 9 Guitar Instrument Rack



Introducing our multi-sampled guitar chord instrument exclusive to **Acoustic Guitar Toolkit**. Featuring 6 chord functions with long, short and palm muted variants (5ths only), 7 editing tools, 7 processing racks and available in Simpler & Sampler formats. Use this Push-ready rack to create beautiful and beguiling guitar chord progressions in an instant.

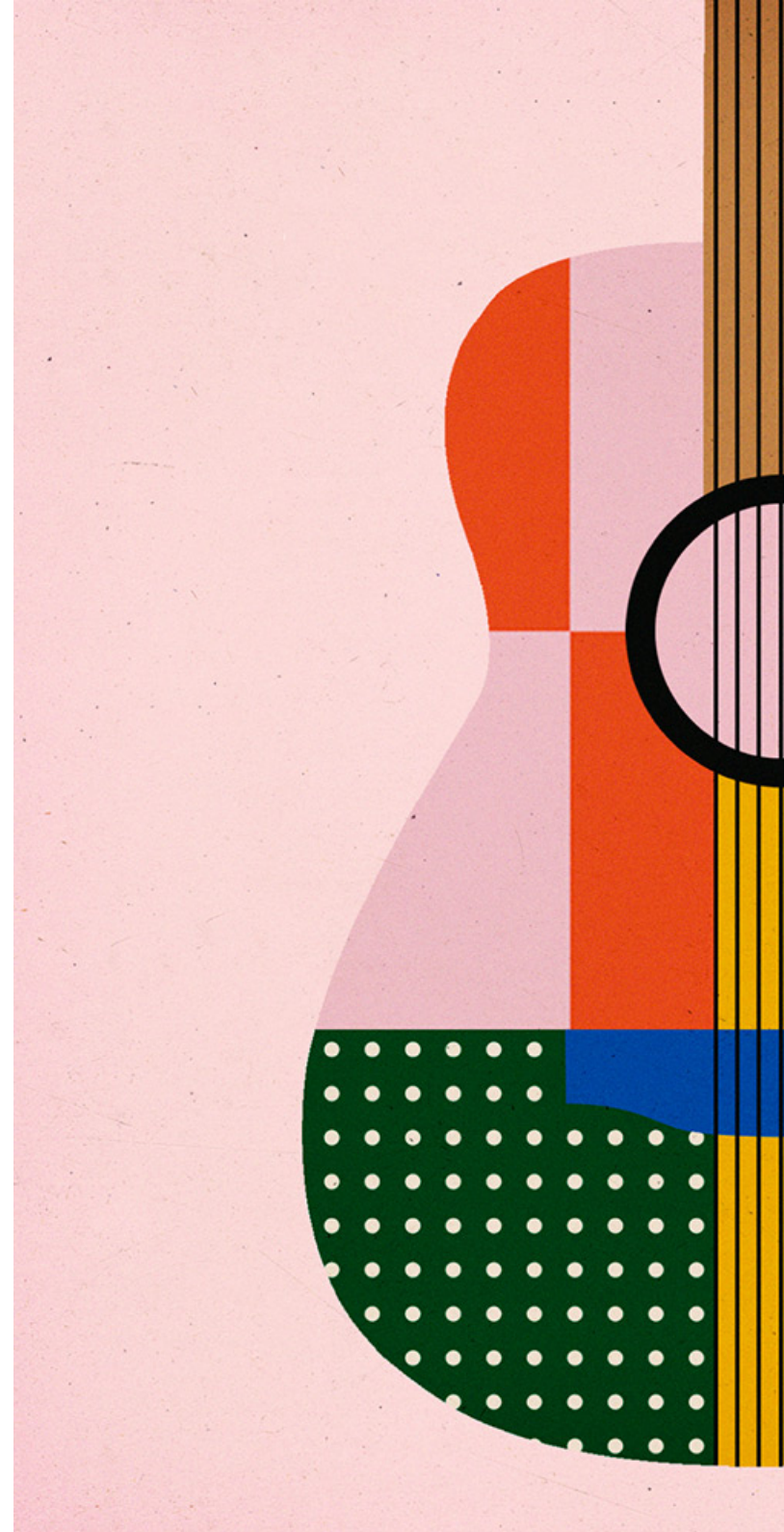
Editing tools:

- Sample Select > Switch between 6 multi-sampled guitar chord functions.
 - Chord Type info can be found on the next page.
- Vibrato / Tremolo > Exclusive to this release, add increasing Vibrato (1 to 64) or Tremolo (64 to 127).
 - Note: At value 0 no effect is applied.
- Filter > A 12-db low pass filter. Carve away unwanted high frequencies and soften your sound.
 - Note: As the Filter is lowered some Filter Envelope is applied to add subtle movement.
- Intensity > Add FM, Resonance and Filter Drive with the OSR circuit. Add warmth at low values or grit at high values.
- Spread > Add width and thickness with slightly detuned second voice.
- ADS > Use the Attack, Decay, Sustain parameters to take control of your transients.

Processing Tools:

- Dirt > Add a touch of warmth or go electric. Dial in for instant distortion & beef up your sound with maximum grit.
- Excite > Add a touch of sparkle and detail to your sound with this easy to use exciter module.
- Deep Chorus > Brand new and exclusive. Stack 4 custom chorus modules to add width and classic chorus tone.
- Delay > Add some tripped out delay with our classic delay line.
- Ripple > Instant off-kilter delay with this techno-inspired delay line.
- Reverb > Dial in for instant reverb or dive in create a custom reverb tone with our Quad Verb module.
- Glucose > Squash and squeeze your sound together with our Glucose rack featuring 4 compression units.

Ableton 9 Guitar Instrument Rack - Extra Information



Our guitar instrument is constructed out of multi-sampled guitar chords from F1 to E2. The instrument itself is playable from C-2 to G8, but it will sound best in the range F1 to E2 as outside of this range the highest and lowest guitar samples are being pitched up or down accordingly.

The following Chord Types and Functions are assigned to the following numerical value on the **Chord Type** control:

1. 5ths (Power Chords) - Long
2. 5ths (Power Chords) - Short
3. 5ths (Power Chords) - Palm Muted
4. Major chord - Long
5. Major chord - Short
6. Major 7 chord - Long
7. Major 7 chord - Short
8. Minor chord - Long
9. Minor chord - Short
10. Minor 7 chord - Long
11. Minor 7 chord - Short
12. Suspended 2nd (Sus2) chord - Long
13. Suspended 2nd (Sus2) chord - Short

Tip: The Chord Type control can be changed at any time to switch chord functions but play the same root note. It can also be automated in Ableton's Sequencer and Clips. Try creating a basic chord progression using power chords and then adjust the Chord Type control to quickly and easily add complexity and depth to your progression.
