Ableton 9, Reason 10 and Logic Pro X Instruments

Fire up our racks and instantly create dark sequences & ghostly progressions with our Ableton, Logic and Reason chord racks. Packed with modern takes on classic FX, these racks allow you to switch between bass & chord one shots on the fly and instantly tailor them to your production. Details below.



Editing Tools

Description

- Sample Select** Switch between key mapped one shots on the fly, playable across the keyboard. In Reason & Logic: Sample switch via MIDI velocity 1 to 24.
- Filter** A 12-db low pass filter run to soften and clean your sound.
- Intensity** Crank intensity and transform your sound. Add PRD circuit filter drive, a hint of FM and pitch envelope (Ableton only).
- Pluck** Add some bite to your sound with some filter resonance and filter envelope. Use with the Filter for maximum effect.
- Slide** Add some portamento to your sound with our simple Slide control.
- ADS Controls** Take control of your transients with Attack, Decay, Sustain and Release.

Processing Tools

Description

- Dirt** Add warmth and saturation with our advanced distortion rack.
- Clarity** Dial in some Clarity using this bespoke EQ and saturation rack, based on classic tube EQs.
- Phaser & Chorus** Add some separation and width to your sound with our bespoke Phaser and Chorus modules.
- Flutter** Dial in some instability and width with Flutter.
- Delay** Add some tripped out delay with our techno inspired delay line.
- Space** From subtle and smooth to aggressive and metallic, add an extra dimension to your sound with our Space reverb module.
- Bonus EQ** Exclusive to Logic users, further contort and process your sound with this EQ.
- Deep** Exclusive to Reason users, Add depth and intensity with custom compression & distortion.

Please note: The above instruments require Ableton Live 9.7.7 / Reason 10.2 / Logic Pro X 10.4.2 or newer. These racks are compatible with Ableton Live Standard and Suite. FX Patches can be found in the "daw fx patches folder". The Ableton adg instrument files are found in the Instrument Rack Project folders. The Logic and Reason Instruments can be found in the bass & chord one shot folders.
